Within her practice, she explores the perceptual and ontological aspects of how objects and images relate to challenge the viewer's attention to expanded dimensions of colour, materiality, and space. Her main focus is on the border segments of the photographic image. By investigating its representational and physical nature through experiments with the material and the immaterial, the borders between the visible and invisible begins to shift. Revealing the possibilities in abstract photography alongside the intersections between photo and sculpture, the core of her practice is particularly based on analogue photographic techniques blended with digital UV printing and thermoformed plexiglass. By treating the photograph as a tactile medium, she attempts to create 'photo-objects' activated through dynamic installations and printing strategies. These techniques allow a play with digital photographic images in balance with chemical processes such as photosensitivity and colour mixing. Her work thus offers an escape from bi-dimensional, wall-based photographic conventions, and navigates the viewer's attention towards the fluidity of the medium through an expanded and forward-thinking approach.








